

Why license my dog?

- You should license your dog because it's the law.
- Dogs that are licensed are guaranteed to be free of Rabies.
- A license makes it easier to identify a stray dog. Licensed dogs are returned directly to the owner, while un-licensed dogs are sent to the Humane Society.

When should I get a license?

Every dog five months or older must be licensed annually. The cost ranges depending on your city, town, or village regulations. Spayed or neutered dog licenses are lower in cost! (A late fee of \$5 is assessed for dogs registered after the date required by your city, town or village.)
